- Please make sure that you are fully aware of your examination venue (place) and start time.
- Arrival time should be 1 hour before your exam; however, on exam days with high registrations candidate's arrival should be 1 hour and 15 minutes.

## 2. Cambridge Speaking Exams Instructions:

- Please note that your final Statement of Entry and your timetable are the documents you should have and follow for examination dates & and timing.
- Candidates sitting the exam should arrive at their examination venue no later than the maximum arrival time that is mentioned for them in the exam schedule.
