- 1 Funnel for filling burette.
- 1 White tile.
- 1 Thermometer (-10° to +110° c at 1c°)
- 1 Pipette and pipette filler 25 ml.
- 1 Test tube holder.
- 1 Balance minimum accuracy 0.01g weighing to 200gm.
- 1 Permanent marker.
