- 30 cm ruler with millimetre scale.
- Stop- watch reading to 0.1 s or better.
- 180-degree Protractor with 1-degree divisions.

Exam Day Instructions:

- Candidates are to proceed to the waiting area maintaining social distancing from one candidate to another.
- Candidates must make sure they take all their belongings with them when they leave the exam room. Anything left behind after the exam (such as a pencil case), these items may be destroyed for hygiene reasons;
- Please make sure that you are fully aware of your examination venue (place) and start time.
- **Seat numbers**: Your seat number changes for every examination. Before each examination, you must check your hall and seat number on the venue noticeboard.
- Please note that your final Statement of Entry and your timetable are the documents you should have and follow for examination dates & and timing.
- Mobile phones, Watches, MP3 players, bags, personal radios, or any electronic devices are not allowed into the examination hall or at laboratories during practical examinations; candidates may be disqualified from the examination session if they do not abide by this rule.
- Candidates are not to bring any personal valuables on the test day, The British Council is not responsible for handbags or valuables left unattended.
- Candidates are to bring their own stationery to all exams.
- Students arriving at the examination venue, not in school uniform will not be permitted to sit for the examination under any circumstances.
